- Site and Dates:** 2/14 and 2/20 at high seed – 7 pm start times

- Schools:** Cole Valley Christian, Marsing, Melba, McCall, New Plymouth, Nampa Christian
- Seeding:** 1. based on 2017-18 WIC record  
2. Ties broken using the WIC Tie-breaker system.
- Uniforms:** The highest seeded team is the home team and wears their light uniforms.
- Programs:** Provided by Marsing High School
- Expenses:** Teams will be reimbursed by using the “share system”.
- Locker Rooms:** Will be assigned. They should be available 45 minutes prior to game time. No shooting on the floor unless you are warming up prior to your game. No one will be allowed to shoot more than 30 minutes before game time unless both coaches are at the location and agree to step on the playing surface. Locker rooms will be monitored but **we will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.**
- Trainers:** You should plan to bring your own supplies. St Lukes will plan on being there for trainer services.
- Admission:** All team members, stats, coaches, band members (and band director to identify them); cheerleaders and mascots (in uniform only), half time performers and IHSAA passes will be admitted for free.

- Passes:** **Only IHSAA passes will be accepted.**
- Bands:** **Please notify tournament director** (Tim Little, Marsing) 24 hours in advance if you plan on performing during the game. **A designated band area will be provided upstairs in the gymnasium across from your team's bench.** Bands may play before the game, at timeouts, and during the quarter and halftime breaks. A trailer may be played after a made basket. Directors need to discuss a playing order before the game in the event that there are two bands.

- Halftime:** If your group would like to perform please notify the tournament manager. Performances should not exceed 6 minutes in length.
- Cheerleaders:** Please perform in front of your designated area. No cheering during game situations.
- Officials:** Officials are chosen by the coaches and assigned by the Board of Control. Timers and scorers are assigned by the tournament manager. Schools hosting the high seed games are responsible for assigning the timer and scorekeeper.
- WIC League and Third District All Stars:**
